### Wakakirri Break-up party

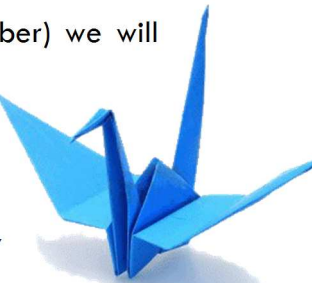
Next Wednesday (2 November) we will hold our final activity for Wakakirri this year, in the Hall from 3:15 – 4:30.
