At school the computers the students use access the online world through an Education Queensland internet service based in Brisbane which is heavily filtered and ensures a safe online environment at school.

Many of our students use social media applications outside of school with possibly no internet filtering occurring. This can lead to situations where they are no longer 'Cyber Safe'. In year six we run a student personal development program which includes a professional external speaker talking with the students about the positives and perils of the online world and how to stay 'Cyber Safe'. We are complementing that program this year with a Cyber Safety program being run for the year five students. On Friday, Constable Rebecca will be talking with the Year five students about being 'Cyber Safe' and using social media applications responsibly.
