This poster provides information on the recommended minimum exclusion periods for infectious conditions and will assist medical practitioners, schools, pre-schools and child care centers to meet the requirements of the Public Health Act 2005.

For example;

Conjunctivitis

Exclude until discharge from eyes has ceased, unless non-infectious conjunctivitis. Some medical conditions require exclusion from school or child care to prevent the spread of infectious diseases among staff and children.
